WHEREAS, Contract No. 22-B-07 entitled "Water Transmission Main Improvements to the Industrial Loop" (the "Contract") was awarded to Grade Construction of Paterson, New Jersey ("Grade") of Fair Lawn, New Jersey (the "Contractor") at PVWC's Commission Meeting dated May 11, 2022 (PVWC Resolution 22-053) in accordance with the authorized scope of work, and with reimbursement to be on a time-and-materials basis, not to exceed \$6,199,555.39; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 covered the unexpected removal of 6-inches thick of concrete subbase and additional test pitting used to investigate unknown subsurface conditions for removal and stockpiling of abandoned PSE&G gas mains that obstructed the work area which increased the total adjusted Contract Price by \$122,175.90, bringing the revised not to exceed to a total of \$6,321,731.29; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 2 covered out-of-scope work due to unexpected subsurface conditions which included unexpected removal of and stockpiling of abandoned PSE&G gas mains that are obstructing the work area, removal of buried concrete valve chamber, removal of concrete saddle around 48-inch inlet line to Levine Reservoir, repairs to damaged unmarked electrical conduit, replacement of storm inlet and additional test pitting which further increased the total adjusted Contract Price by \$141,180.87, bringing the revised not to exceed to a total of \$6,462,912.16; and

RESOLUTION OF PASSAIC VALLEY WATER COMMISSION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE OF THE BIDDING THRESHOLD TO \$53,000 AND DELEGATING THE AUTHORITY TO AWARD "WINDOW CONTRACTS" TO THE QPA

DATE OF ADOPTION: JULY 23, 2025

Introduced by Commissioner: RON VAN RENSALIER

Seconded by Commissioner: **DEB RIZZI**

WHEREAS, amendments to the Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq. P.L. 1999, c.440 (the "Act") became effective on April 17, 2000 and certain discretionary provisions contained therein were previously adopted by the Commission ("PVWC") by Resolution # 00-48 dated July 26, 2000 (Copies of which are on file in the office of the Administrative Secretary of PVWC); and

whereas, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3a of the Act gave local contracting units the ability to increase their bid threshold if a qualified purchasing agent was appointed and granted the authorization to negotiate and award such contracts below the bid threshold established by the Act, and PVWC subsequently appointed a qualified purchasing agent; and

WHEREAS, Lisa Bresemann, QPA Certificate # 1797, has been appointed Qualified Purchasing Agent ("Purchasing Agent") pursuant to Resolution No. 22-044; and

WHEREAS, the said bid threshold is periodically reviewed and adjusted every five years by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services ("NJDCA") in accordance with the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law provides for award of the Contract to the lowest responsible bidder following receipt and analysis of bids; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3(c), the new threshold for contracting units (such as PVWC) having a qualified purchasing

agent has been increased by the Division of Local Government Services to \$53,000; and

WHEREAS, among the changes to the Act, the Qualified Purchasing Agent of an entity may now be delegated the authority to award contracts having an anticipated value in excess of \$17,500 but below the \$53,000 bid threshold (commonly known as "Window Contracts"); and

WHEREAS, the increased threshold for bids and quotations enables PVWC to solicit for, and obtain goods and services more efficiently and effectively; and

WHEREAS, PVWC desires to take advantage of the increased bid threshold and implement other provisions authorized thereby as forth in greater detail herein; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3(c) of the Act, and N.J.A.C. 5:34-4 et seq., PVWC finds that it promotes more cost efficiency to increase the bid threshold to \$53,000 in accordance with the policy of the State of New Jesey as promulgated by the Division of Local Government Services; and

WHEREAS, as also permitted by the act, previous PVWC requirements for solicitation of competitive quotations shall be modified and supplemented by provisions (a) though (c) as set forth hereinafter and all of which are in conformance with the Act;

- (a) Competitive quotations shall not be required for PVWC staff to award quotations less than \$7,950.00 (15% of the bid threshold); and
- (b) Three (3) competitive quotations, where practicable, shall be sufficient for PVWC to award quotations that are over \$7,950 (15% of the bid threshold) and under the bid threshold of \$53,000;

(c) For the purposes of advancing efficiency in the award of contracts, PVWC desires to delegate to Lisa Bresemann, in her capacity as the Qualified Purchasing Agent, the authority to award contracts having an anticipated value in excess of \$17,500 but below the \$53,000 bid threshold;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of PVWC, its users and constituent municipalities at this time to increase the bid threshold to \$53,000 and to modify the said thresholds and other requirements including those for competitive quotations as set forth above;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by Passaic Valley Water Commission, in the County of Passaic, New Jersey:

- 1. The bid threshold shall be hereby increased to \$53,000; and
- Competitive quotations shall not be required for PVWC's authorized and certified Purchasing Agent to award quotations less than \$7,950 (15 percent of said \$53,000.00 bid threshold);
 and
- 3. Three (3) competitive quotations, where practicable, shall be sufficient for the Purchasing Agent to award quotations that are under the \$53,000 bid threshold adopted above, but less over \$7,950 (15 percent of said \$53,000.00 bid threshold); and
- 4. The Purchasing Agent is hereby granted the authority to award contracts having an anticipated value in excess of \$17,500 but below the \$53,000 bid threshold detailed in the Act; and
- 5. No officer or employee of the Commission may award a purchase or contract on behalf of the Commission pursuant to this Resolution except for the Purchasing Agent, and the Purchasing Agent is only authorized to do so after having received a written certification from the Chief Financial Officer of the Commission verifying the availability of sufficient funds to award the purchase in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law; and

- 6. That an appropriate officers, employees and officials of PVWC, are hereby authorized to perform such acts and execute such documents as are necessary to implement the terms and intentions of this Resolution; and
- 7. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.2(b), the Administrative Secretary of PVWC is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution, along with any other required documentation, to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and
- 8. That this matter shall be advertised as required by New Jersey law, in accordance with an appropriate form of notice, and a copy of this Resolution shall be placed on file and made available for public inspection at the office of the Administrative Secretary of Passaic Valley Water Commission.
