



PVWC Levine Storage Tanks Contract #24-B-05

Construction of upgrades and improvements to Levine Reservoir on Grand Street in Paterson, NJ, at a capital cost of \$41,819,780.00 were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits preventing contamination from wildlife and environmental factors while ensuring compliance with the Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule (LT2ESWTR) for customers in the PVWC service area.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
